

2018 Klondike Rules Important Information

Please read!

- Camping will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - Please **DO NOT** camp in the immediate area of a competition station (see maps). Otherwise, you will be asked to move.
 - Follow the directions of the parking staff.
- Register in advance or on-site upon arrival.
 - \$8.00 per attendee.
 - No unit fee this year.
 - Please bring a check as credit cards will not be accepted on-site.
 - Advance registration up to 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, 1/17:

- Schedule:
 - 7:30 – 9:00 Registration and sled check in
 - 9:00-9:15 Opening and score sheet handout at flagpole.
 - 9:15-12:00 Activities stations
 - 12:00–1:00 Lunch! Stations closed during lunch
 - 1:00–2:30 Activities stations
 - 3:00-4:00 Sled races
 - followed by Trophy presentation and Closing Ceremony
- Hodge Park Athletic Fields is a new location with **new rules**.
 - *No ground fires*; they should be contained and off the ground.
 - Vehicles **MUST** park on the paved area.
 - Straight in or back in – no parallel parking.
 - This will require trucks towing trailers to unhitch.
 - You should be able to find parking near or adjacent to your camping area.
 - I have appointed “Parking Czars” to enforce this.
 - If necessary, we will deduct competition points.
 - ***There is no running water on-site.*** We will have 600 gallons of water. But it is *strongly* suggested that you bring water with you. You may want to have each attendee bring at least a quart with them, in addition to any bulk water the troop might bring. Do *not* rely solely on the water at the event.
 - Water will be located in large “totes” on trailers at either end of the campground.
 - This area is a city park and athletic fields.
 - As good stewards of our environment and guests of the Parks Dept., we will be expected to leave the area as we found it.
 - Port-a-Johns will be distributed throughout the camping area, the competition area and near Registration.
