

## 2019 Klondike Rules Important Information

*Please read!*

- Camping will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
  - Please **DO NOT** camp in the immediate area of a competition station (see maps). Otherwise, you will be asked to move.
  - Follow the directions of the parking staff.
- Smith's Fork Park is a new location with **new rules**.
  - *No ground fires*, except where permanent fire rings exist.
    - In all other areas, they must be *contained and off the ground*..
  - Scouts *must* stay away from water (river and creeks)
    - Anyone caught playing in the water will be asked to leave.
  - Vehicles must park in the paved lots or on the gravel areas in the campground.
    - Straight in or back in on paved lots – no parallel parking.
    - This will likely require trucks towing trailers to unhitch.
    - There are 3 paved parking lots, plus gravel parking in the campground area.
      - No parking on the paved road in the campground.
        - Use the gravel parking spaces.
      - You should be able to find parking near your camping area.
    - There will be volunteers to assist with parking.
      - Please follow their directions.
      - If necessary, we will deduct competition points.
  - *There is running water on-site*. But it is *strongly* suggested that you bring water with you. You may want to have each attendee bring at least a quart with them, in addition to any bulk water the troop might bring. Do *not* rely solely on the water at the event.
  - Water will be located at 1 spot in the campground.
  - There is no trash service. Haul it in; haul it out.
  - This area is a city park sports complex.
    - As good stewards of our environment and guests of the Parks Dept., we will be expected to leave the area as we found it.
  - Port-a-Johns will be distributed throughout the camping area, the competition area and near Registration.
